The contract period is for Six Months (6) months with a Twelve (12) month defects liability period.

All interested bidders shall be limited to two (2) persons and shall meet immediately on Long Ground Road at the site of the proposed Cargo Building. A sign-in sheet will be circulated and attendance is encouraged.

Bids should be received no later than **Friday**, 8th **September 2023 at 3:00 p.m.** Late bids will be rejected. *Bids* will be opened publicly at the address above on **Friday**, 8th **September 2023 at 3:05 p.m.** Bids meeting the minimum technical criteria to qualify will be evaluated for price. The GOA is not bound to accept the lowest of any bids. This bid process may be cancelled or rejected without any liability to GOA.
