The Anguilla Air and Sea Ports Authority (AASPA) intends to apply a budgetary allocation to payments under a contract for Concessionaire – BPFT – Lot 3. The AASPA now invites sealed proposals from eligible bidders for the Concessionaire – BPFT – Lot 3, as defined within the bidding documents. The contract period is for **two** (2) **years** with the option of multiple two (2) year extensions at the discretion of AASPA and the concessionaire.

Bidding will be conducted through a Request for Quotation (RFQ) procedure in keeping with the Public Procurement and Contract Administration Acts and Regulations.

Proposals should be received no later than **Monday**, **03**rd **July**, **2023** at **12:00 noon**. Late proposals will be rejected. Proposals will be opened publicly at the address above on **Monday**, **03**rd **July**, **2023** at **1:30pm**. The GOA is not bound to accept the lowest of any bids. This bid process may be cancelled or rejected without any liability to GOA.
