The Ministry of Infrastructure, Communications, Utilities and Housing and Tourism (MICUHT) intends to apply a budgetary allocation over the coming years to execute on this project, subject to availability of funding.

The MICUHT now invites sealed responses to the Request for Expression of Interest (REOI) from eligible bidders for the Airport Redevelopment Program Package 3 – Air Terminal Building as defined within the Request for Expressions of Interest. Bidders will receive an email with the link for this meeting. There will be no on-site pre-bid meeting.

Each submission must include five (5) hard-copies of the Expressions of Interest along with one (1) soft copy memory stick and must be submitted to the address below no later than **4:00pm** on **Friday, 8th September 2023**. The sealed envelope containing each submission shall be clearly marked "CONFIDENTIAL" and "Expression of Interest – Airport Redevelopment Program Package 3 – Air Terminal Building.
